One Bedroom Carriage House

This two-story carriage house with garden gate entrance from Taylor Street was featured in John Berendt’s novel *Midnight in the Garden of Good and Evil*. An antique staircase with a built-in “burglar alarm” described by Berendt, leads to a large bedroom with a view of the garden, a king-size bed and sitting area with 27-inch cable TV and VCR, and a full bath.



The garden level includes a spacious living room and dining area furnished with antiques, a convertible sofa for extra guests, a 27-inch cable TV, a powder room and a full kitchen with washer and dryer.



The kitchen is stocked with orange juice, fruit, cereal, muffins, coffee, tea and milk for guests to enjoy at their leisure.



Convenient on street parking is available on Whitefield Square.
